

SUBJECT: Recommendation for sampling at John Day During high temperature

DATE: February 3, 2009

FPAC has reached agreement on a recommendation for sampling at John Day Dam during periods when temperatures meet or exceed 70°F. FPAC recommends sampling be limited to two days per week for condition sampling. Sampling should occur between the hours 7 am and 1 pm.
