







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SUBJECT: Trip Reports and Flow Vector Diagrams from ERDC Columbia and Snake River Project Modeling

DATE: August 7, 2017

The Fish Passage Advisory Committee (FPAC) would like to formally request the trip reports and white board snapshots that show the flow vectors from all past ERDC modeling trips at all Snake River and Lower Columbia projects. Any information that applies to each model run would also be beneficial, including: which units are operating, spill pattern, spillway weir operation, total flow level, total spill, etc. We feel that having a historical database where the group can access past hydraulic modeling in a timely fashion will help the FPAC and others make decisions when faced with in-season fish passage issues at Columbia and Snake River projects. We plan to make this database publically accessible on the Fish Passage Center website and cataloged by project and date of modeling.

We appreciate your assistance with this matter. Prior years trip reports and white board snapshots would ideally be obtained by the end of September of 2017.
